THIS APPLICATION WILL ONLY BE CONSIDERED IF IT IS ACCOMPANIED BY:

1. A copy of the applicant's SAT and ACT Scores.
2. A copy of the applicant's high school transcript, including class ranking, and 1st semester grades of the senior year.
3. A letter from the applicant to the scholarship committee. This letter should reflect information and insight that will present a word picture of the applicant. It should also reveal his/her hopes, ambitions, and future educational goals.
4. One letter of recommendation (Non-Relative) showing community involvement, citizenship, moral character, and conduct.
5. The completed "Parent or Guardian Endorsement Form".
6. Recipients of the Scholarship must submit proof of enrollment such as a tuition statement in order to receive scholarship money.
7. Essay on how 4-H/FFA has influenced your school years and how you plan on using this influence to better your community in the years to come. 350-500 words.

Friends of Flint Inc. Scholarships will be awarded on a point basis. Deadline for applications is April 01, 2022. The Scholarships will be awarded on March 31, 2026. Applicants will be scored on a point system as follows:

1. 1 point for every year in 4-H/FFA.
2. 1 point for every year in 4-H/FFA Shooting Sports.
3. 3 points for every year attending a Friends of Flint Benefit, starting in 2019.
4. GPA- 95-100=5pts; 90-95=4pts; 85-90=3pts; 80-85=2pts; 75-80=1pt
5. 1-5 points for Essay(350-500 words)

*Scholarships will be determined by dollars raised during each year's Friends of Flint Benefit that will be held in April of every year. Scholarships will be paid in August to the institution or Trade School of winning applicants.
